Eco Fix Oil is a New Zealand Ministry for Primary Industries approved Maintenance Compound, conforming to MPI C15 (All Animal Products Except Dairy). “This is permitted to be used during processing of food to lubricate moving parts of equipment whereby the lubricated surface is either an integral part of the food contact surface, or is contiguous with the food contact surface and contamination could result (...)”.

It is not out of reach for a product with this certification to make some incidental contact to foodstuffs.

Standard 1.2.3 of the New Zealand Food Standards Code identifies food allergens which must be managed and labeled in foodstuffs. These allergen substances are:

- cereals containing gluten and their products, namely wheat, rye, barley, oats, spelt and their hybridised strains other than where these substances are present in beer and spirits standardised in Standards 2.7.2 and 2.75. respectively.
- crustacea and their products
- egg and egg products
- fish and fish products
- milk and milk products
- peanuts and soybeans and their products
- added sulphites in concentrations of 10 mg/kg or more; and
- tree nuts and sesame seeds and their products.

As there is potential in the ordinary use of a C15 Maintenance Compound for food contamination to occur, it is important that any potential allergen substances contained in that compound is identified.

We confirm that Eco Fix Oil does not contain any substances listed as allergens in the New Zealand Food Standards Code.
